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INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS FOR TOURIST VISAS

Please note the following and file an application accordingly for tourist visa to visit Nepal.

1. Please send your passport, visa application with affixed photograph, visa fee in CAD dollars and postage-paid self-addressed envelope (i.e. Xpresspost, Priority Courier, registered mail, FedEx, Purolator etc.)
2. Passport should remain valid at least for six (6) months from the date of entry into Nepal.
3. Visa fees:
If applying for the first time within the calendar year, the following fees apply:
 - a) CAD \$60.00 for 60 day Single Entry;
 - b) CAD \$150.00 for 60 day Multiple Entry;
 - c) GRATIS – Free for three (3) days or less.If you are re-applying within 150 days of your last visit to Nepal, within the same year, the following visa fee will be charged:
 - a) CAD \$60.00 for 30 day Single Entry;
 - b) CAD \$60.00 for 30 day Multiple Entry.
4. Children ten (10) years or older carrying a separate passport or endorsed on their parents will be charged visa fees as per above. There will be no fee for children under ten (10) years. However, a visa is required.
5. Visa fees can be paid by money order or certified cheque made payable to the ROYAL NEPALESE CONSULATE GENERAL (Toronto). If two (2) or more applicants are applying together, you may make a single money order or certified cheque multiplying the fee by the number of applicants. **PERSONAL CHEQUES OR UNCERTIFIED BUSINESS CHEQUES ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**
6. Visa once issued cannot be withdrawn, visa fees cannot be refunded, and entry to Nepal must be made within six (6) months from date of issue to remain valid.

8. You can also apply for a visa with the Royal Nepalese Embassy in Washington, DC. Their address is:

9. Tourist visas may also be obtained at any of the following entry points:
Tribhuvan International Airport, Kathmandu; Biratnagar (Jogbani), Birgunj (Raxaul), Bhairahawa (Sunauli) and Kakarbhitta (Panitanki) on Nepal – India border and Kodari on Nepal – China border.
10. Tourists traveling on a short duration visa can get them extended if they so desire. The Department of Immigration, Kathmandu and Pokhara Immigration Office extend visas and charge US \$30.00 for 30 days for a total period of 120 days. Tourist visas for a further period of 30 days can be granted if the Department of Immigration is satisfied with the reason furnished by the applicant without exceeding altogether 150 days between January and December of the current year.
11. Tourists carrying more than US \$2,000.00 or equivalent of foreign currency are requested to declare so in the Custom Declaration Form at the time of arrival in Nepal. Those returning from Nepal with undeclared money exceeding US \$2,000.00 or equivalent of foreign currency may be interrogated for further legal actions in accordance with Foreign Exchange Regulation Act of Nepal.
12. Trekking permits are not required for trekking in most areas of Nepal including the popular Everest region, the Annapurna region and the Langtang Himal region. However, for specific enquiries and permits, please contact the Immigration Department in Kathmandu, Nepal.
13. Tourists traveling by car should possess a valid Passage de Carnet.
14. It takes three (3) business days to issue a visa after the application is received at the Consulate.
15. Only tourist visas are issued by our office.

INFORMATION ABOUT THE CONSULATE FACILITIES

1. The Royal Nepalese Honorary Consulate General issues visas for visitors to Nepal, however is **not a full service Consulate**, and does not perform many consular functions that is the job of an ordinary consulate.
2. The Honorary Consul General is a principal of Kanish & Partners, CA. as a goodwill gesture Kanish & Partners has permitted the operation of the Nepal Consulate from its location.
3. We encourage a drop off and pick-up system for visas, just as most other Consulates in Toronto do. Our hours for this service are 10:00am to 4:00pm Monday – Friday.
4. Kanish & Partners does not have facilities such as “waiting areas” or “work stations” to handle its customers or the Consular visitors. The small area around the main reception is used for mainly a “momentary wait” for those with prior appointments with either Kanish & Partners professionals or the Consul-General to be received immediately.
5. Consular visitors may wish to go across the street to Cumberland Mall (north-east corner) Food Court Area or to Manulife Mall (south east corner) which have ample seating and table facilities available for public use, in the event they wish to fill out an application form and drop it off or pick up a document within a few hours by prior arrangement.
6. The Consulate does not have any staff of its own. Kanish & Partners staff is trained to professionally assist all clients of Kanish & Partners. Other than Dr. Sharma, the Consul General, and his Secretary, the rest of the Kanish & Partners staff do not have knowledge about Nepal and will not be able to answer your questions in a way you may wish to be helped. Please write to the Consulate or ask for an appointment with Dr. Sharma or his secretary to make your visit to the Consulate more efficient and productive.
